**If Jessie walks with Tyson, Samantha will walk with Blake.**

JT  $\rightarrow$  SB

$\sim$ SB  $\rightarrow$   $\sim$ JT

**If Tyrone goes to the bar, Dan does not go.**

T  $\rightarrow$   $\sim$ D

D  $\rightarrow$   $\sim$ T

**My phone will die if I do not charge it.**

$\sim$ C  $\rightarrow$  PD

$\sim$ PD  $\rightarrow$  C

**If you bring a stopwatch to the LSAT, you will get written up.**

Stop  $\rightarrow$  WU

$\sim$ WU  $\rightarrow$   $\sim$ Stop

**If Brian gets malaria, he will die in Tanzania.**

BM  $\rightarrow$  DT

$\sim$ DT  $\rightarrow$   $\sim$ BM
